How to use this list

This 'was-is' list has been drawn up in order to clarify the changes which have been made to the *Definitielijst Toepassingsgebieden Gewasbeschermingsmiddelen* (Definition list of areas of application for plant protection products, DTG) in reference to the presently used *Standaard Opzet Toelatingsbeschikkingen, SOT-lijst: Teeltgroepen, toepassingssectoren. Categorie: Gewasbeschermingsmiddelen, versie 1.0* (Standard scheme for authorisation orders, SOT list: Cultivation categories, application sectors. Category: Plant protection products, version 1.0).

One important difference between the new DTG list and the old SOT list is that the DTG list specifies crop subcategories within crop categories and areas of application. As a result, a number of crops have been grouped in a crop subcategory. For instance, in the DTG list the 'Grains' category has been subdivided into 'Winter Grains' and 'Spring Grains'. This also makes it possible to combine separate crop categories with similar backgrounds into one new crop category. For example, the new crop category 'Pulses' consists of 'Dry-harvested Peas' and 'Dry-harvested Beans'. These last two used to be the crop categories 'Agricultural Peas' and 'Agricultural Bush Beans'. The category names have been changed and they have been changed to crop subcategories. For the DTG list, it was decided to place as many crops as possible in the 'crops/objects' column, which means that different subspecies of crops or crop types are not listed as separate crops. For example, the SOT list differentiated between four separate species of clover, but in the DTG list these all fall under the category 'Clover,' and five more subspecies have been included. The subspecies are listed in the was-is list in the column "remarks"
