Hoi 5.1.2.e W,

Hierbij wat info van onze kant over de NVIC-info en hoe Ctgb daarmee omgaat; met dank aan mijn collega 5.1.2.e Woo die deze analyse jaarlijks maakt:

In the Netherlands NVIC is responsible for collecting reports of potential poisonings with chemical products, e.g. plant protection products.

Data on reports of exposure to PPPs collected by NVIC are analysed by Ctgb on a yearly basis.

In case NVIC notices an unexpected increase during the year Ctgb is notified.

The total number of reports of exposure to PPPs is around 300 a year. In 15% of these reports medical treatment is necessary.

Most reports are about situations of accidents or where PPPs were used the wrong way.

In cases where it is clear that correct use of PPPs still leads to poisonings, Ctgb will use the procedure provided for in article 56 PPR to amend authorisations.

The most frequently reported are exposure to glyphosate and to PPPs against snails. The rest is about other PPPs. The analysis of the data for 2013-2019 did not indicate a need to amend authorisations.
