Draft agenda for the meeting on glyphosate renewal of the AGG and the German institutes

The last renewal of glyphosate was decided upon 2017 and had an expiry date of five years. Therefor a new decision on the renewal glyphosate must be taken in 2022. For the renewal four member states are appointed: France, Hungary, Sweden and The Netherlands. They act as one RMS and are organized in the Assessment Group on Glyphosate, AGG.

Germany acted as RMS for the last renewal and the AGG would like to discuss the German experiences with the dossier.

Participants from the AGG will be the four members of the steering committee and possibly several experts.

The aim of the meeting is to learn from the German institutes about procedural and assessment issues the institutes encountered during and after the assessment so the AGG can proactively tackle these issues.
