Details of the decision	<p>The European Commission has decided by Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) 2016/1313 (d.d. 1 August 2016) that per August 22, 2016, plant protection products may not contain the co-formulant POE-tallowamine:</p> <p><i>'In the light of current scientific and technical knowledge it is appropriate to amend the conditions of use of the active substance in particular by excluding the co-formulant POE-</i></p>

	<i>tallowamine (CAS No 61791-26-2) from the use in plant protection products containing glyphosate.'</i>
Reasons for the decision	POE-tallowamine is more toxic compared to glyphosate. The NOAELs and LOAELs are lower (repeated dose toxicity, effects on fertility and developmental toxicity) and POE-tallowamine may cause DNA damage at high doses which are cytotoxic.
Notes	The authorisation holder was given the opportunity to submit comments. A grace period was granted that consisted of four months for sale which is subsequently followed by five months for use.
