**Subject:** NL response to COM request regarding possible future renewal of glyphosate

Dear Mr. 5.1.2.e Woo dear 5.1.2.e Woo,

In response to the Commission's request to the MS to indicate whether they would be willing to act as RMS for the possible next renewal of approval of glyphosate, we hereby let you know that the Netherlands will not volunteer for this task. The Ctgb as competent authority does not have the required resources for this task. The Netherlands already accepted three times its share of substances in the AIR IV and AIR V renewal programmes (11% of substances vs. 3.87% of EU population, excluding UK). NL is also one of the few MS that took over work from the UK because of Brexit. Furthermore, in the same period the applicant has to submit the glyphosate renewal dossier, the Netherlands will receive 9 dossiers to evaluate for their renewal which will take up all available resources earmarked for evaluation of renewal dossiers.
