Glyphosate: in DE the mainstream discussion is on how to reduce the use of glyphosate; In NL there is no big discussion. Pre-harvest use in DE is now restricted; in NL it is still authorised, but the call for reduction is getting stronger. Non-professional use is still possible in NL; in DE it is under discussion to ban it as is all use on hard surfaces (except specific permits e.g. for railway tracks). In NL there is now a ban on all professional use of glyphosate outside agriculture.

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4b	Recent developments in neonics Vote on 27 th April to restrict the use of 3 neonics to indoor use only. Since it is an interim intervention in the conditions of approval, Ctgb thinks that the burden of proof lies with the Commission. The EFSA only took into account mitigation measures that are already in the GDs. The COM did not take into account some of the mitigation measures that the MSs could take at a national level. With their decision the COM precludes

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8a Cumulative risk assessment

BfR and UBA produced a paper in 2014 how they assess this risk. (Paradigm shift in the risk assessment of cumulative effects of pesticide mixtures and multiple residues to humans and wildlife: German proposal for an new approach) Their concepts work. The Ctgb calculates combitox, but not cumulative risk assessment in the way the RIVM states. Working on MRL level, we'll find 'paper risks' about everywhere. The only possible way forward will be monitoring.
