Dear 10.2.e , all,

We think that it would be beneficial to have an opportunity during the workshop to try the full assessment in order to see if the assessment causes problems. We do not have the resources to develop a full case study. However, we could offer to help expanding one of the suggested case studies with the assessments of accumulative effects and guttation water assessment or alternatively to present simple examples on how to do these assessments without developing a full case study. Probably it would be better to go for option 1 in order to have a complete case.

10.2.e looks into developing an excel sheet for the evaluation of 1st tiers. An initial version of the excel calculator could be presented at the workshop. If it is found useful then it could be developed further after the workshop.

I hope that you find our suggestions for developing the program useful.
